GOAL:

First grade students will begin exploring their interests/talents and associate them with a possible future careers thereby promoting academic, social/emotional, and career success.

RESULTS

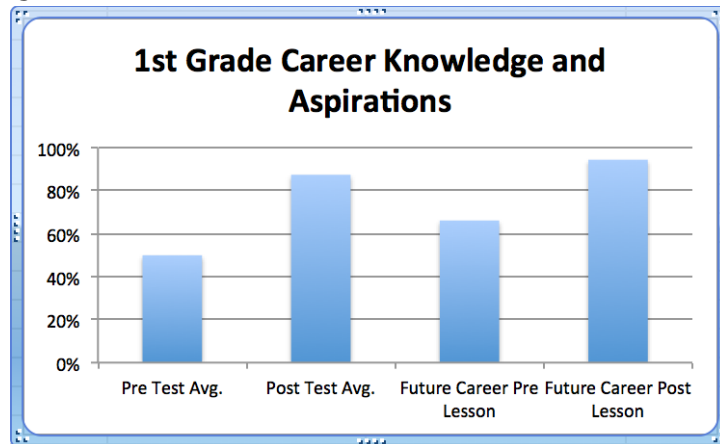
Based on a pre-test and post-test analysis, 1st grade students initially lacked understanding of possible career options. Initially the average score on the pre-test was 50%. Prior to the lesson only 66% (98/148) of 1st grade students had one or more ideas of what they wanted to be when they grew up. After the completion of the lesson the first grade students were able to do the following:

- 94.5% (140/148) of first grade students were able to name a possible future career based on their talents and interests.
- 100% of first grade students scored an 88% or higher on the post-test regarding potential careers.

IMPACT STATEMENTS

Due to the school counseling 1st grade lesson on careers, the first grade students were able to relate their education to a future career. 94.5% of first grade students were able to name a possible future career based on their talents and interests. 100% of first grade students scored an 88% or higher on the post-test regarding potential careers.

PROGRAM IMPLICATIONS

The school counseling lesson provided to 1st grade students during the month of March educated students on career possibilities. It also educated students on the importance of our interests and talents when choosing a future career path. First grade is given the first career lesson, but it is continued in every grade level to help promote college and career readiness. As a result:

- 94.5% (140/148) of first grade students were able to name a possible future career based on their talents and interests.
- 100% of first grade students scored an 88% or higher on the post-test regarding potential careers.
